Re: Vaporous Hyperoxia Therapy (“VHT”) usage with cellular tissue products

To whom it may concern:

I have been using VHT as an adjunct to my wound care regimen since 2019 with excellent results. My partners and I have utilized this therapy in over 200 patients and found it highly beneficial in improving and healing many complex wounds, including diabetic foot ulcers, venous stasis, and dehisced surgical wounds.

In addition, I have been utilizing it in the preparation of wound beds and in conjunction with the application of cellular tissue products from MiMedx and Smith+Nephew. Medicare and several private practice payors have authorized Vaporox treatments (up to 3 times per week) along with applying amnion and chorion allograft membrane grafts once per week. Anecdotally, concomitant VHT therapy and appropriate debridement have increased the efficacy of the allograft applications with my patients (six in total).

Vaporox’s therapy has been highly beneficial to my practice both clinically and financially. We have had no complications, and our patients are impressed with this application of cutting-edge technology.
